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Education, training, and information form the backbone of the fifth cooperative principle, playing a pivotal role in a cooperative's success and sustainability. By equipping members, employees, and officers with essential knowledge and skills, cooperatives cultivate a sense of responsibility, community, and awareness that drives growth and progress.

Education has always been central to the cooperative movement. Early cooperators understood that education was not just a privilege but a catalyst for collective transformation—a path to enlightenment, social progress, and the fulfillment of cooperative ideals. This belief, deeply rooted in the Rochdale principles, remains vital today, reaffirmed by the International Cooperative Alliance (ICA).

For Oro Integrated Cooperative (OIC), member education is more than a mandate—it is a cornerstone of development. An informed membership actively contributes to decision-making, upholds cooperative values and principles and maximizes the benefits of cooperative services. To this end, OIC prioritizes continuous learning through various platforms.

In addition to the annual General Assembly, OIC's Education Committee hosts bi-annual Ownership Meetings across branches to update members on programs, projects, and initiatives. The OIC newsletter complements these efforts by sharing timely and relevant information and keeping members engaged and informed about the cooperative's progress.
